Real estate update:

The spring real estate market historically starts the week after Super Bowl. Interest rates went up slightly at the end of last week. But overall the inflation rates over the last 6 months have gotten better, but is still too high for the Fed to feel comfortable cutting the Federal funds rate (but also didn't raise it!!). They aren't expecting to cut the rate in March either. BUT economists say they expect mortgage rates to go down over the course of the year despite what the Fed does. It's expected to be a very good year for both buying and selling.

If you are planning to buy in 2024, now is the time to meet and get a plan in order. It is expected that 2024 will be another low inventory and high demand year. First thing to do is meet with a lender and get your preapproval process underway. With low inventory markets, houses move fast and you don't want to lose out because you didn't properly plan.

New from Woods, Water, Furs and Feathers:

The weather feels wonderful but with it being a warm dry winter, be sure to keep any outdoor fires contained and watched.

Also before going out on the lakes, check the ice depth. The ice is very unpredictable this year.

Following is the recommended minimum ice thickness:

Walking: 4 inches

Side-by-side: 7 to 8 inches

Driving a small car: 9-12 inches

Driving a truck: 13 to 17 inches

Driving a large truck with icehouse: 20 inches
